What is digital transformation?

Digital transformation is the integration of digital technology into all areas of a business, fundamentally changing how you operate and deliver value to customers



Arguably it's more than that – it's about understanding that adopting technology within a business requires cultural change as well – a shift towards ongoing experimentation and innovation

The Cloud

scalable on-demand services accessed over the internet



SaaS

Software as a Service software that is cloud-based that you generally pay a subscription fee to use (PAYG) important for connecting apps

Application Programming Interface

A simplified and defined way for other systems to connect to, and interact with an app

Cloud Integrators

People who connect and configure apps to talk to each other

Legacy Software

Old systems and software that still perform a role but could be replaced

Figuring out what you do

With a **task audit.** A log of tasks someone does, and how long it took – recorded over a fixed period of time

It ensures you completely capture what takes place within a business, while also helping identify opportunities

It flags where an app or automation might impact a person – and help with change management





With a **process map.** A diagram that illustrates the flow of a process, and the various steps along the way

Figuring out what you want to do ...

User stories are a way to capture the who, what and why in an informal way.

They are used in agile software development

It's not necessary to put the 'so that' but asking the question of 'why' does help qualify for someone the value in the thing they want

As a ? I want ? so that ?

As a manager I want to **approve all expenses over 5,000** so that I can control cashflow

As a bookkeeper I want to **attach source documents to all transactions** so the context is there for our accountant

As a bookkeeper I want to **automate the entry of bills in Xero** so I can spend time doing better things

The app might not do everything you want today, but will it in the future?


